SUMMARY OF INDUSTRY STATISTICS AS AT APRIL, 2013

In April, 2013 the total number of active voice subscriptions in Nigeria increased to 119,356,665 from 117,281,669 in March, 2013 while Teledensity also increased from 83.77 to 85.25 in April, 2013 thereby indicating an increase of 1.76%.

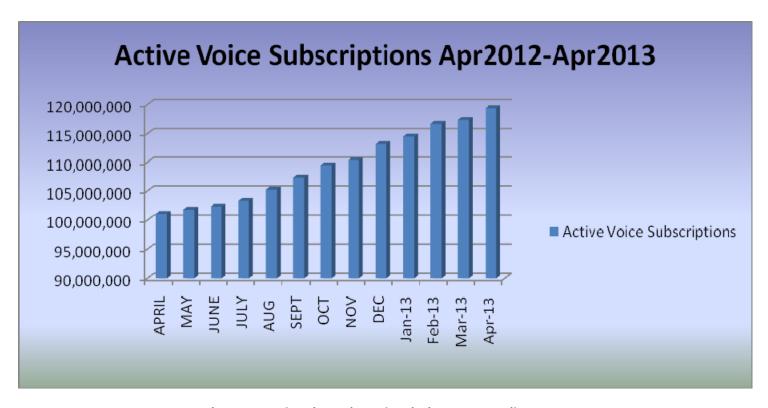


Figure 1: Total Active Voice Subscriptions as at April, 2013

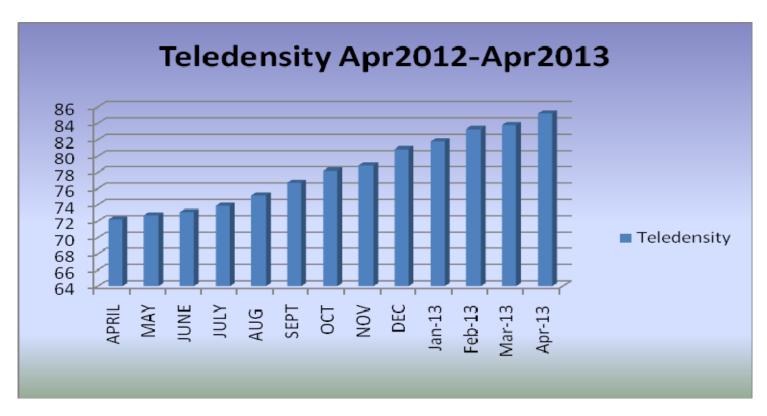


Figure 2: Trend of Teledensity (April, 2012 – April, 2013)

The graphs above further illustrate that the number of active voice subscriptions and teledensity have consistently increased month on month. Teledensity increased from 72.20 in April, 2012 to 85.25 in April, 2013.

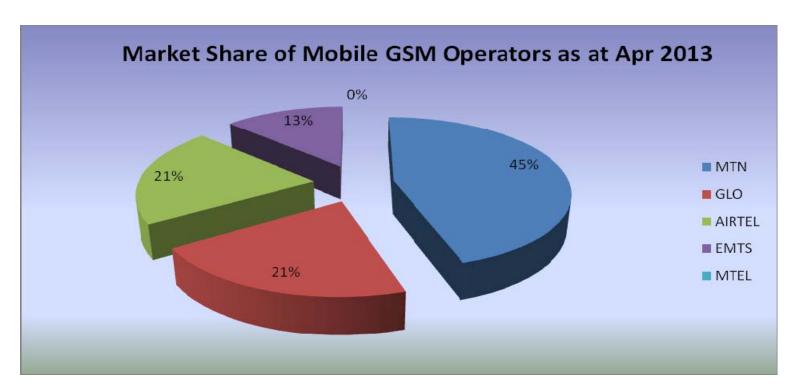


Figure 3: Market Share of Mobile (GSM) Operators as at April, 2013

As at April, 2013, the total number of active voice subscriptions for this market segment was 116,325,790 indicating an increase of 1.89% from the 114,172,440 active voice subscriptions recorded in March, 2013. A breakdown of the total number of active voice subscriptions reveals that the four major Mobile GSM Operators [MTN; GLO; AIRTEL & EMTS] each had 52,642,943; 24,252,533; 24,051,385; & 15,120,409 active voice subscriptions thereby indicating that MTN; GLO; AIRTEL & EMTS each have 45%; 21%; 21%; 21%; 8 13% share of the Mobile GSM market segment.

The analysis of data for active voice subscriptions for this market segment therefore shows that MTN; GLO, AIRTEL & EMTS each recorded an increase of 2.63%; 1.76%; 1.61% & 0.04% respectively in the month of April 2013.

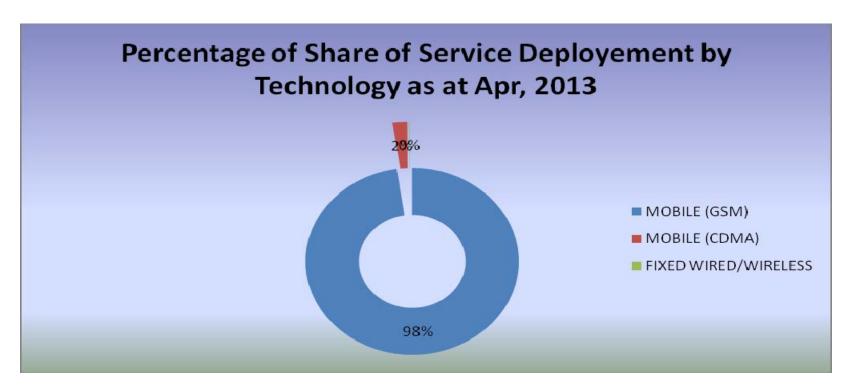


Figure 4: Percentage of Market Share of Service Deployment by Technology as at April, 2013

As at April 2013, the Mobile (GSM) market segment maintained its lead as it accounted for 97.46% of the market. The Mobile (CDMA) and the Fixed Wired/ Wireless Market segments each accounted for 2.20% and 0.12% respectively also indicating a continued decline in the market share of these segments. Our analysis reveals that the Mobile (CDMA) and the Fixed Wired/ Wireless Market segments continue to lose market share to the Mobile (GSM) market segment.

The month of April, 2013 witnessed an increase in the number of active internet subscriptions. Active internet subscriptions increased from 34,637,158 in March, 2013 to 35,081,005 in April, 2013 indicating an increase of 1.28%. The trend further shows that there has been a steady growth in total active internet subscriptions from November, 2012 till date.

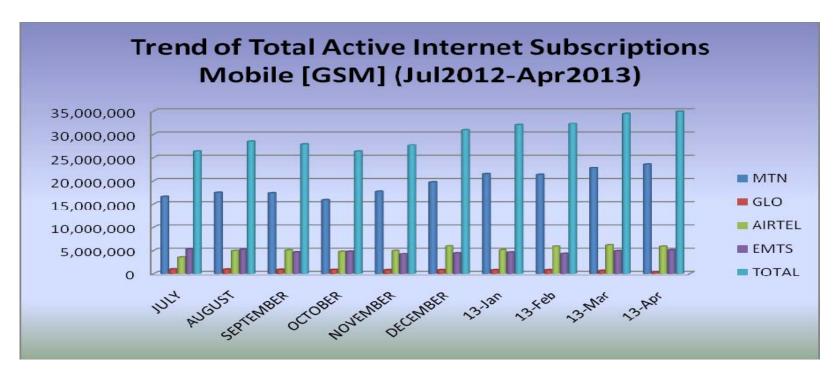


Figure 6: Trend of Total Active Internet Subscriptions- Mobile GSM (July, 2012 - April, 2013)

The graph and table above shows the trend of total active Internet subscriptions for four (4) Mobile GSM Operators [MTN; GLO; AIRTEL; & EMTS] from July, 2012 to April, 2013. While MTN & EMTS recorded an increase of 3.85% & 3.58% respectively in their number of active internet subscriptions, GLO & AIRTEL witnessed a decrease 47.84% & 4.53 respectively in the number of active internet subscriptions.

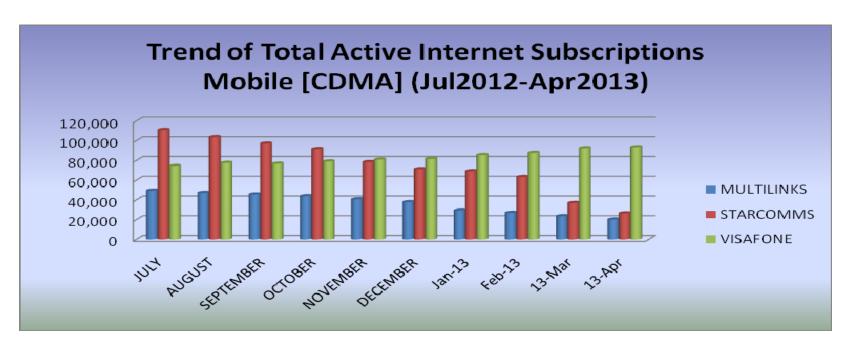


Figure 7: Trend of Total Active Internet Subscriptions- Mobile CDMA (July, 2012 - April, 2013)

The Mobile (CDMA) market segment accounts for just a small fraction of active internet subscriptions. As at April, 2013 this market segment only accounted for 0.39% of the total active internet subscriptions. The active internet subscriptions for Multilinks and Starcomms continued to decrease In April, 2013, while Visafone on the other hand experienced a 1.10% increase in active subscriptions.
